Please remember the following when playing on the course.

- Repair pitch marks on the greens
- Replace divots when possible
- Rake bunkers after playing out of a bunker
- Players should aim to keep up with the group in front of them. If a group falls more than a hole behind then they should allow the group behind to play through.
- However, if the group in front are immediately behind the group in front of them, there is no point in pushing them from behind as your group will have nowhere to go. In this situation, please refrain from playing shots which are likely to reach the players in front. If there are shorter hitters in your group then play ready golf and let the shorter hitters play when they will not be able to reach the players in front. Please simply exert common sense!

Thank you to all who attended. There is a link below to a training video of how to use the Heartsine defibrillators which have been donated by Springfield. Important things to remember in the event of a cardiac arrest is call

for help (it is much easier and far more successful with more folk helping), **DO NOT STOP** chest compressions while the defib is being unpacked and the pads are being taken out of the defib and connected to the person, continue chest compressions until the defib tells you to not touch the patient!
