General Information

1. The Tournament will be under the control of the Tournament Committee and its decision will be final in any dispute that may arise.
2. The maximum playing handicap allowance for any competitor will be 21.
3. No handicap alterations will be made between qualifying rounds. For matchplay and consolation rounds adjusted handicap will apply. Players have the responsibility to check and alter their own handicap following the qualifying rounds. No handicap alterations will be made between consolation events.
4. Tournament registration: please report to starter at least 10 minutes prior to your tee time. Failure to do so may result in a playing penalty.
5. Current handicap and CDH is necessary for registration.
6. All Scorecards must be returned to The Tournament Hub immediately after completion of round where players must enter scores in the appropriate terminal and submit cards.
7. Competitors must notify the tournament administrator of their complete availability for Match Play stages.
8. Competitors are NOT permitted to play the course between the Monday and Tuesday qualifying rounds; Rule 5–2–b applies.
9. If a competitor arrives late for their starting time: the starter will, at their discretion, try to accommodate the competitor at a later time and a TWO SHOT penalty will be applied.
10. The course will be closed for play at 3.30pm on Sunday 2nd August to allow for course preparations.
11. Competitors have courtesy of the course on Sunday 2nd August for a practice round (played in fourballs). Advance reservations for practice round must be made to the office. (Tel No 01667 452741). A professionals sweep will also be available to enter.
12. Local Rules are displayed on the scorecard, club noticeboard and are available from the Starters. Any adjustments to the local rules will be displayed at the tournament hub.
13. The Tournament Committee expect players to keep up with the group in front. Slow Play will not be tolerated and competitors are advised that penalties will be imposed in accordance with the Rules of Golf.
14. Suspension Of Play – Rule 5-7-b – If circumstances dictate that one round has to be abandoned, qualification will be based on a single round. If both qualifying rounds are abandoned, a single qualifying round will take place on the Wednesday and the qualifiers will be reduced to 16 in each section.

General Information continued

15. Qualifying
 - a. The leading 32 scratch aggregate scores will go forward to the scratch matchplay stages. The leading 4 players will be seeded.
 - b. The Handicap sections will be split into two divisions (playing handicap *up to 12; and 13 - 21*). The leading 32 aggregate scores in each category (after the leading 32 scratch qualifiers have been removed) will go forward to the handicap matchplay stages. There will be no seeded players in the handicap sections.
 - c. Ties in the qualifying rounds for prizes and/or places in the matchplay stages will be decided on the modified WHS (Last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 holes)
 - d. **SENIOR PLAYERS**- players aged 55 and over on the day before the tournament **MUST** enter "SENIOR" on card to qualify for the Senior Prize.
16. You cannot win a Scratch and Handicap prize in the same competition.
17. Match Play results must be notified directly to The Tournament Hub. Prize Vouchers will be issued immediately from The Tournament Hub to those losing in 1st, 2nd rounds, quarter finals and semi-finals.
18. Halved matches in the matchplay stages will be decided by continuing play from the 19th Hole, strokes will be given/received as if in the stipulated round.
19. Consolation competition entry sheets for Stableford (Thursday) and 3-Ball Better Ball Team (Friday) will be available from 9.00am on the Wednesday and Thursday respectively at The Tournament Hub. You can only enter yourself into a tee time when not still playing in matchplay. Priority tee times will be given to main sponsors. **THE COMMITTEE REGRET THAT THEY CANNOT GUARANTEE TEE TIMES FOR THE CONSOLATION ROUNDS.**
20. Members and Visitors are reminded that a smart casual standard of dress is required both on the Course and within the confines of the Clubhouse.
21. Due to insurance regulations - Players cannot charge batteries on the premises.
22. Distance Measuring Devices – R&A approved distance measuring devices ARE permitted to be used in the tournament.
23. Players under 18 years may not participate in sweepstake events.
24. Tick season in the UK typically occurs from March to October, with the peak activity occurring from June to early September. Ticks are most active during the warmer months, thriving in damp, grassy, and wooded areas. It's important to be vigilant during outdoor activities, especially in areas with high tick populations, to prevent tick bites and the associated health risks, such as Lyme disease.

LOCAL RULES

1. Out of bounds

A ball is out of bounds if it lies beyond any boundary fence or line of white stakes. The white stakes separating the 16th hole from the practice range define the out of bounds. A ball lying in or beyond the ditch containing the hedge and surrounding the putting green and car park, is out of bounds.

2. Immovable Obstructions

All staked trees, trees protected by plastic sleeves, trees under one club length in height and sponsor boards, are immovable obstructions with free relief. This does not include tree stumps, where the ball needs to be played as it lies or penalty relief taken under unplayable ball.

3. Sand Waste Areas

Sand waste areas throughout the course are defined as being in the “general area” of play under the Rules of Golf. Specifically, these are: the area behind the 4th tee/5th green/3rd green. The two areas between the 4th and 5th fairways. The area to the front right of the 7th tee. The area short right of the 7th green. The area to the right of the 10th hole. The area to the left of the 11th hole, short of the green-side bunker, the area to the right of the 11th hole.

4. Sprinkler and Drain Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16. In addition, when a ball lies within the general area and interference exists from a sprinkler or drain head on the line of play that is within two club-lengths of the putting green and two club-lengths of the ball, relief may be taken under Rule 16. (Exception: there is no relief under the Local Rule if the player chooses a line that is clearly unreasonable).

5. Ground Under Repair

Areas throughout the course may, from time to time, be encircled by a white line and indicated by a GUR sign. Relief from these areas should be taken under Rule 16. Players are advised that areas where gorse has recently been removed are part of the general area and a ball lying in these areas is either played as it lies or is deemed unplayable and relief taken according to rule 19 with one shot penalty.

6. Aeration Holes

On the putting green, a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be placed at the nearest spot not nearer the hole that avoids the situation. If the drainage hole cap on the 8th green interferes with the players stance or swing, or is in the line of a putt free relief can be taken.

7. Embedded Ball

A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark in the general play area of the course may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it originally lay, without penalty. This includes in the revetted face of a bunker, the ball should be dropped at nearest point of relief in the general area.

8. Avoidance of Slow Play

Please keep up with the game in front, invite faster matches to play through, be ready to play when it is your turn and move away from the green immediately on having completed the hole. Nairn Dunbar are fully supportive of “Ready Golf” and encourage players to play according to the principles of ready golf.

9. Buggies

Any competitor must have a medical certificate to use a buggy during the event. Competitors may not share buggies during the qualification and match play stages.

10. Bridges & Sheds

When a ball is in the general area, i.e. not in a penalty area, all bridges, paths and sheds, are immovable obstructions, with free relief available. However, this free relief relates only to stance or swing relief and not to line of play.

11. Sleepers in bunkers on 9th and 12th holes

If a ball is in the bunker, i.e. touching sand, there is no relief. If a ball comes to rest on a sleeper or the sleeper interferes with swing or stance, and the ball is not in the bunker, i.e. touching sand, free relief is available under rule 16 Abnormal Course Conditions.

LIGHTNING - The Golf Club will use whatever means it has available to determine if there is a danger from lightning and take whatever actions it believes are appropriate to keep players safe. Players may also stop play on their own when they believe there is a danger from lightning (See rule 5.7a).

If there is a suspension due to lightning, all players should immediately mark the spot of their golf ball and leave the course immediately, sheltering in the clubhouse. Players will be advised as and when it is safe to return to the Golf Course.

Out of bounds at the 16th hole

There is an out of bounds down the right-hand side of the 16th fairway separating the hole from the practice range.

There are white posts marking the line of the out of bounds but the exact line of the out of bounds is set by the strimmed area of grass with out of bounds defined as the practice range side of the strimmed area i.e. if any part of the ball is touching the strimmed area it is in bounds.

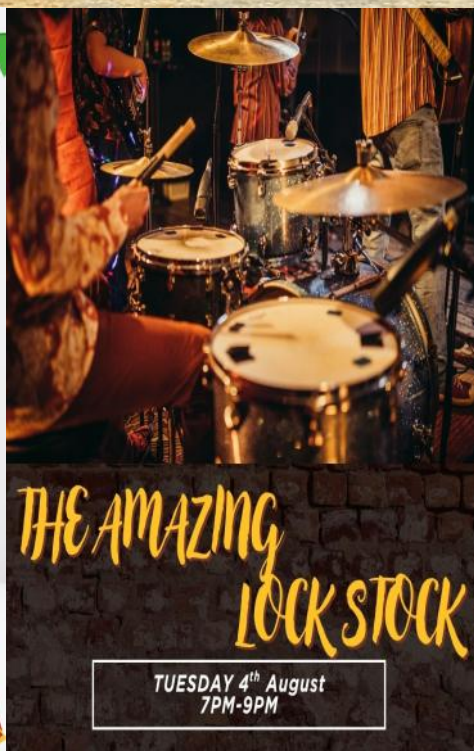
